Susan B. Cochran

October 6, 1956 - July 14, 2011

Susan Marland Cochran was born in Chicago, Illinois and grew up in Jackson, Mississippi.

Susan and Butch Cochran moved to Columbus in 1977 when Butch started his practice here. Because Susan had a deep appreciation for the arts, she and Butch attended their first Columbus Symphony performance at the Three Arts Theater. On the way home, Susan was quiet and Butch asked her what was wrong. Susan said that she knew the CSO was in need of help and she intended to find a way to make that happen.

She saw that more money had to be raised to accomplish this and that the CSO needed a better location for its performances. Her vision set her to work and her involvement with the symphony began.

In 1978, Jim Sigmund invited Audrey Baird of the American Symphony Orchestra League to visit Columbus and to help reorganize the Columbus Symphony Women's Association.

Susan agreed to be the first president under the new structure.

The need for a major fundraiser was apparent and Susan presented a great idea that she had seen executed in her hometown of Jackson, Mississippi. With the help of Sherry Wade and other dedicated volunteers, the Gourmet Dinners were born.

These soon became some of the most anticipated social events of the year. For more than thirty years, hosts and hostesses have given a wide variety of parties in their homes and other venues throughout the area. There have been many different themes and styles to please both young and old. The CSO has benefitted greatly from the funds raised over the years and appreciates the countless hours put in by volunteers who plan the series yearly.

The name of the fundraiser has been changed several times but the participants still come to enjoy the hospitality. Some folks buy out parties every year and invite their friends to join them. Many new friendships have been made across these tables. The CSWA is now the Columbus Symphony Guild and has both men and women as members.

This year we honor Susan and her vision for the CSO through this series of Noteworthy Parties, as they are now called. She was a dedicated and tireless volunteer for the arts and we acknowledge her significant contributions to the CSO.
